# NORMS OF PROMOTION FOR NURSERY TO Std. II (2019-20)

- As per NPE-86 and NCERT frame work (1988), "emphasis needs to be on continuous assessment of the overall growth and development Physical, Mental, Social, Emotional and Spiritual of the learner."
- 2) All the students from Nursery to Std. II will be assessed thrice throughout the session in different areas like Language Skills and its development, Socio-Emotional Development, Cognitive Development, Physical development, Creative and Expressive Arts etc.
- Whole Syllabus will be divided in III Terms & Assessments .
- 4) I Assessment will be conducted during the months of April to August, II-Assessment will be conducted during the months of September to December & III- Assessment will be conducted during the months of January to March.

- 5) Grades for Discipline, Health & Hygiene, CCA etc. will be decided on the basis of classroom observation, performance, active participation in activities etc. in the entire session.
- 6) Students will be awarded for 100% attendance and the Best Dressed Student in the entire session on the Result Day.
- 7) Every Wednesday, Students from Nursery to Std. II will wear House Uniforms.
- 8) Every Saturday will be observed as Holiday for them.
- 9) There will be 'Parents Teacher Meeting' on every Second Saturday.
- 10) For every student, 85% class attendance is compulsory.
- 11) There will be "GRADUATION CEREMONY" for the students of UKG at the end of the session. In which students will be awarded by Certificates & Medals for the completion of Kindergarten.

## NORMS OF PROMOTION FOR STD III TO IV

- 1. All the students of III & IV standard will be evaluated and assessed throughout the session not only in Scholastic Areas but in Co-Scholastic Areas also.
- Evaluation is an integral part of teaching learning process. In this a teacher will take the following 8. steps-
  - \* Set up the learning objectives.
  - \* Plan out the activities to meet the learning objectives.
  - \* Carry out the activities.
  - \* Evaluates the learning outcome.
- All the students will be evaluated in the entire session through "Four Unit Tests". In total there will be Four Unit Tests in the entire session. Students have to appear in all the Four Unit Tests.
- 4. First Unit Test will be conducted during the month of July, Second Unit Test will be conducted during the end of August, Third Unit Test will be conducted during the end of November to the first week of December and Fourth Unit Test will be conducted during the second week of February & the first week of March.
- Subjects mentioned in the Unit Test schedule are compulsory for III & IV Standard students and the performance of students in these subjects will be counted for the promotion to the next standard.
- Grades in various subjects and overall grade will be allotted on the basis of 5 points scale, given as follows:
  - (a) 90% to 100% A+ (b) 75% to 89% A
  - (c) 56% to 74% B (d) 35% to 55% C
  - (e) below to 35% D

- Overall grade in the individual subject will be decided on the basis of total marks scored in the entire Four Unit Tests including Internal assessment of 20 Marks.
- Each Unit Test will be of 20 marks subject-wise and will not be conducted again in the cases of absentees on any ground.
- The Weightage of Internal Assessment is further divided as given below:-
  - (i) 5 marks for timely & regular submission of class work & homework assignments.
  - (ii) 5 marks for Subject enrichment activities.
  - (iii) 5 marks for Projects & Assignments.
  - (iv) 2 marks for Neatness, Proper maintenance & Completion of notebooks.
  - (v) 3 marks for attitude towards Subject.
- First Project and Assignment will be given by the concern subject teachers/ class teachers in the last week of April. It will be collected from the students just after the Summer Vacation.
- Second Project and Assignment will be given before Dussehra Holidays. It will be collected from the students just after Deepawali Break.
- 12. The Student has to score minimum 33% marks to pass in each subject and in aggregate.
- 14. The given Unit Test schedule is subjected to be changed if and when the Institution feels the requirement due to genuine reason.
- 15. Students will be awarded for 100% and the best dressed students in the entire session on the Result Day.

### NORMS FOR STANDARD V to XII

- (1) (a) In Grade V, the entire Academic year will have FOUR UNIT EXAM & FINAL EXAMINATION at the end of the Session.
  - (b) Each Unit Test for each Subject will be of 20 Marks only.
  - (c) The FINAL EXAMINATION for each subject will have a weightage of 50 Marks.
- (2) 20 Marks are allotted for Internal Assessment. The Weightage of Internal Assessment is further divided as given below:-
  - (a) 5 Marks for timely & regular submission of Class Work & Homework Assignments.
  - (b) 5 Marks for Subject enrichment, such as Multiplication Tables in Mathematics, Reading / Recitation with proper intonation in language etc.
  - (c) 5 Marks for Activities / Projects.
  - d) 2 Marks for Neatness & Proper maintenance of Notebook / Project reports etc.
  - (e) 3 Marks for Attitude towards Subject.
- (3) The Final Examination Result of Grade-V will be prepared as follows:-30% of all Unit Tests + 20% Internal Assessment + 50% Final Examination . ie. { 30 + 20 + 50 = 100 }
- (4) Five Point Scale Grading will be allotted in Optional Subjects i.e. D.S., G.K., Drawing, Computer

#### NORMS FOR STANDARD - VI TO VIII

- (1) According to latest Examination Reforms introduced by CBSE, the whole session has been divided into two terms. Each term consists of 100 -100 marks. In the first term (April to September) PT1, PT2 and HALF YEARLY EXAM will be conducted. In the second term (October to March) PT3, PT4 and ANNUAL EXAM will be conducted.
- (2) 10% syllabus of first term will be asked again in the second term of 6th std., similarly 20% syllabus of first term will be asked in second term of 7th std. & 25% syllabus of first term will be asked in second term of 8th std.
- (3) TERM-1 will be conducted in the month of September TERM-2 will be conducted in the month of February & March for the classes from V to X.
- (4) Overall grade will be awarded after adding the weightage of PT1 + PT2 + TERM1 + PT3+ PT4+TERM2.
- (5) Students must score minimum 33% marks in 'Internal & Main Exam' separately in each subject both in Term-1 and in Term-2 taken together in order to qualify the exam.
- (6) Students have to appear compulsorily in all the Exams / Tests and in all the Co-Scholastic activities.
- (7) Syllabus of VI to XI std will be completed up to 15/01/2020 and syllabus of XII std. will be completed up to 31/10/2019
- (8) Project and Assignment will be given twice to the students from Std. VI to VIII by the concern subject teachers in the last week of April, which will be collected back from them just after the summer vacation & then in the month of December which will be collected back after Winter Vacation.
- (9) Project and Assignment will be given Once only to the Students of IX & X in the month of October which will be collected back after the Deepawali Vacation.

#### MARKING SCHEME For "STANDARD VI TO X"

- Marks and percentage of the students will be reflected in the Report Book / Progress Report as per the latest norms of CBSE.
- (2) Areas of Assessment and Grading pattern has been categorized as follows:
- [A] SCHOLASTIC AREAS:-{Part 1}:
  - (a) It includes all the subjects like Languages, Science, Mathematics, Social Science or any other additional subject.

[B] CO-SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES {VI-VIII}

For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities in the following areas be carried out by the teachers & will be graded term-wise on a 3-point grading scale

(I) 35 to 50 - A { Outstanding } (ii) 24 to 34 - B { Very Good } (iii) 23 & below - C { Fair }

The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output & teamwork be the genetic criteria for grading in the following Co-Scholastic activities.

- (a) WORK EDUCATION:- Work education refers to skill-based activities resulting in goods or services useful to the community.
- b) ART EDUCATION:- { Visual & Performing Art }
- (c) HEALTH & PHYSICAL EDUCATION :- { Sports / Martial Arts / Yoga / NCC etc. }
- (3) DISCIPLINE{ Class VI VIII }:- The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based
  - on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules & regulations, attitude towards society, nation & others.

Grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3-point grading scale

(i) 35 to 50 - A { Outstanding } (ii) 24 to 34 - B { Very Good } (iii) 23 & below - C { Fair }

- (4) Keeping the various directives of CBSE in mind, it has been decided that in case of grade VIII, the entire academic year will be divided in Two Terms.
- (5) Each Term will have a distribution of {80 written + 20 internal assessment } where 80 marks are allotted to written examination & 20 marks are allotted for internal assessment.
- (6) At the end of each term, Term End Examination will be conducted of 100 marks.
- (7) For the result preparation of Term I, the 100 marks of written examination will be reduced to 80 marks to get final total of 100 marks {i.e.80 written exam+20 internal assessment}
- (8) The Final Exam will be conducted at the end of Term II will also be of 100 marks, which will also be reduced to 80 marks to get final total of 100 marks { i.e. 80 written exam + 20 internal assessment }
- (9) Final Result will be prepared on the basis of the average of Term I & Term II
- (10) For VI to VIII std., Internal Assessment' will cover Periodic Test of 8 marks, Note Book keeping of 4 marks, Project or any other activity of 4 marks & Subject Enrichment of 4 marks for Term I & similar criteria will be followed for Term II also.
- (11) For IX & X std., I Test will be of 25 Marks, II Test will be taken as Half Yearly Exam, III Test will be of 50 Marks. Among these three tests, average of the best two tests will be included in Final Result making. And 'PERIODIC Assessment' for these classes will cover Pen Paper Test of 5 marks, Multiple Assessment strategies to be used { Quizzes, Oral Test, Concept Map, Exit Cards, Visual Expression etc.} of 5 Marks, Portfolio {Classwork plus peer assessment, Self-assessment, Achievements of student in the Subject, Reflections, Narrations, Journals, etc.) will be of 5 Marks, & Subject Enrichment { Social Science Project Work, No changes in other Subjects} will also be of 5 Marks only Once in the entire session.
- (12) It will be mandatory for a student to qualify Term I examination by scoring at least 25% marks in written examination to be able to appear for Term II.
- (13) A retest will be conducted or average marks will be allotted to the students who have participated in any of the Inter-School's Competition or remained Absent due to any Medical Background.
- (14) Entire Syllabus of Term I & Term II will be covered in the final examination which will be conducted at the end of Term II.
- (15) DAVCAE will conduct Term End Examination for both terms i.e. Term II in case of grade VIII & Year End Annual Examination in case of grade XI.
- \*NOTE: In each Area any two activities will be assessed. Calculation of Grade will be done on the basis of 5 points scale and Grade will be given on the basis of Grade Point scored by the students.

#### For STANDARD XI & XII

- (1) Every student has to appear and obtain passing marks separately in Theory as well as in Practical Examination. The minimum passing marks are 33% in each subject and in aggregate.
- (2) The Final Result of Std. XI will be prepared as per the following weightage:-
  - (i) Unit Tests 10% (ii) Half Yearly Exam - 30% (iii) Annual Exam - 60%
- (3) Result will be prepared on the basis of Best five Subjects' Marks Scored out of Six subjects by the students.
- (4) Half Yearly Exam for XI and XII std. will be conducted in the month of September. For XII std. 1st Pre-Board Exam will be conducted in the Second Week of December, 2nd Pre-Board Exam will be conducted in the Second Week of January.
