Bulk SMS System

We are introducing appliances of I.T. in the school and gradually the entire set up in the school is likely to be in digital form. Presently we have started with the bulk SMS facility regarding e-information system in which the SMS will be sent to the parents/staff members for important information as outstanding fee, report, academic performance, attendance, important notice, circulars, unscheduled holidays, results, invitations and absence from the school etc. This may be noted that some information in respect of student's behaviour etc. may be of the 'Confidential' in nature and needs to be discussed with the concerned teacher/department and the Principal. Meanwhile, in case the students have left their home for school and SMS regarding absence is received, the parents must contact the school office/Principal on the land line number 7805-226223 or mobile number of security incharge 7828516575 to know of the standing fact and do the needful.

Passing criteria for students of Std. VIII,IX,XI.

Passing criteria for the students of classes VIII, IX & XI have been detailed time and again to all the parents and the students. Parents are once again advised to please ensure that the attention is paid by their ward towards studies at home too. No request for the ineligible promotion and additional examination is entertained if a student does not qualify or fulfil the passing criteria set by the board.

Important Informations

Short Leave: It can be availed only when parents/ guardians (whose signatures appear on the first page of the school diary of their wards) make a request and collect the students from the school.

I-Card: Students must carry their I-cards with themselves .

Absentism: Students must be regular and punctual to the school. In case of being absent on the previous day, an application countersigned by the parents/ guardians must be submitted on the following day.

School bags:Parents are advised to ensure that school bags contain only the books and other related stationery as per the routine only. Carrying unwanted objects to the school is strictly prohibited and may lead to disciplinary action if found during the random inspection done by the school.

School uniforms & Appearance of students: Students are required to be regular and punctual and attend school in proper uniform. Appearance related to uniforms, hair style, shoes, pants , shirts must be taken into consideration by the parents before sending their wards to the school. Pants sticking to the body or of the narrow shape are not allowed. Hair cut should be formal and be combed properly.

Students violating the dress code or not having proper appearance may not be allowed to attend the class from January 2017. As such get the new set of PRPOER SCHOOL UNIFORM within the period of 10-15 days from now, if required.

Conduct & Etiquettes: The students should not indulge in disruptive activities. The school owns the right to take action and even to remove from the school rolls if a student is found guilty of misconduct or long absence from the school without any information.

Attendance:A minimum of 75 % attendance is a must for appearing in the Annual / Final examination and for promotion to the next class.

Private vehicles: Viewing the safety at all ends, parents whose wards commute the services of private vehicles must submit the details of the vehicles to the school and keep one copy of the same with themselves. Further, no student is allowed to drive the vehicle until having the valid license with them.

Parents Teachers Meeting:-School arranges the Parents –teachers meet on the last working day of every month and also as per the need. This is to make the parents updated with the progress of their wards and to seek their help and views. Parents may also call on to the Principal on working days from 9.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. to get information about their children and to offer any suggestions for the improvement of the school.
